- You must do the work under the supervision of, or with the approval, an adult. That adult should sign your form when you finish.
- Work done with a scout troop, church group, or other organization may count.

EXAMPLES:

- Rake leaves for an elderly neighbor.
- Clean up a local park.
- Help at a local soup kitchen.
- Baby sit (unpaid) at your church so adults can attend a service or meeting.
