

Community Service is helpful work you do for members of your community or the community at large.

- **You should NOT be paid for this work.**
- **You must do the work under the supervision of or with the approval of an adult.**
- **The adult should sign this form when you finish.**
- **Work done with a scout troop, church group or other organization may count.**

Examples:

- **Rake leaves for an elderly neighbor**
- **Clean up a local park**
- **Help at a local soup kitchen**
- **Babysit (unpaid) at your church or other social gathering so that adults can attend a service or meeting.**

MAKE CERTAIN that your parents know what you are planning to do BEFORE you do it.

You may work on this goal during the first three card marking periods of the school year.
