This school year you can put your reading abilities to the test and try to collect 12 different book genres. Below you will find answers to the most frequently asked questions about the program.

- Who can participate in the program?
 - Students at Reuther Middle School are eligible to participate.
- How do I collect a book?
 - You can select any book that you want to read. Once you complete the book, stop by the library and fill out the book genre form. Then you will receive a book badge to show that you finished the book.
- What books do I need to collect to be an ultimate book trainer?
 - This year there are 12 book genres you can collect
 1. Poetry
 2. Science Fiction
 3. Nonfiction
 4. Biography/Autobiography
 5. Historical Fiction
 6. Graphic Novel
 7. Realistic Fiction
 8. Fantasy
 9. Mystery
 10. Short Story
 11. Drama
 12. Adventure
- Can a book count for more than one badge?
 - Even if your book qualifies for more than one genre, a book can only count for one badge. You will need to choose which one you would like to select.
- What do I do with the book badges I collect?
 - Book badges should be added to your gotta read 'em all! backpack to showcase all the genres you've read. Completed gotta read 'em all! backpacks can be turned in for a chance to win the grand prize at the end of the school year.
- In order for a book to count, does it have to be a library book?
 - No. A book can be owned, borrowed, or bought to count. It does not have to be from the Reuther library.
- Are there prizes?
 - For each book genre you collect, your name will be entered for the possibility to win prizes throughout the year. Prizes include books, bags, Pokemon items, gift cards, and much more!
- How often are prizes drawn?
 - Prizes are awarded at the end of each semester. An additional grand prize drawing will happen at the end of the school year.
