Welcome to the Fall 2017 Intramural Season! The Enrichment Department handles the registration for intramurals. Please call or go online to register – **Do not turn in registrations to the Main Office.** Registration is first come-first served, so promptness is important. Most intramurals will run once a week from 2:30 – 3:30 for 5-10 sessions, however, the dates and times for each intramural are included on the reverse side of this flyer.

### REGARDING INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR

School rules apply for all intramural classes. If a student's behavior is inappropriate, he/she may be asked to report to the office and call home to be picked up early. If a second occurrence of inappropriate behavior occurs, a student may be removed for the duration of the sessions. A refund will not be issued.

### NUT FREE POLICY

The Enrichment Department has a peanut/nut free policy for all of our programs. Please do not bring any food items that contain nuts of any kind into our after-school activities, but we cannot guarantee that every activity or location will be nut free.

### REGISTRATION INFORMATION – Register Early to Avoid Cancelled Classes!

Payment must be made at time of registration; registration may now be paid online by setting up a household profile by following the information below. Classes are funded by your fees; classes that do not meet minimums will be cancelled. Full refunds will be given if a class is cancelled by the Enrichment Department. TEAMS Program: Notify TEAMS supervisor of your Intramural classes for a credit.

**REGISTRATIONS MADE LESS THAN 3 BUSINESS DAYS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE INTRAMURAL WILL BE CHARGED A \$10 LATE REGISTRATION FEE.**

### HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE

1. Go to [www.rochester.k12.mi.us](http://www.rochester.k12.mi.us)
2. Click the "Enrichment" tab in the grey navigation bar
3. Click the blue "Register Now" button
4. Click the "sign-in" link on the left side of the page
5. Login using your account information, or create a new account and household

### CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY

- Cancellations made by the Enrichment Department due to low enrollment will result in a full refund.
- Cancellations made more than 7 days prior to the start of class will receive a full refund, minus a \$10 processing fee.
- Cancellations made less than 7 days prior to the start of class will receive a full refund, minus a \$25 processing fee
- Any cancellations made after the start of the second class will not receive a refund.
- Cancellations due to an emergency will receive a pro-rated refund for the number of classes attended, minus a \$10 processing fee if approved by the Enrichment Department.
- Classes cancelled due to weather or teacher absence will try to be made up. If a make up is not possible, no refunds will be given.
